


MRS. ACOSTA'S

We are now in the season of the church year called Lent. The students learned about Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of reflection to remember all that Jesus has done for us. Lent leads us to Holy Week and the Resurrection.

During Bible we learned that Heaven and hell are real places. We read about the “fall” in the book of Genesis. We used a Venn diagram and labeled Heaven, hell, and Earth. We placed believers in Christ, unbelievers, God and His angels, people, the devil and fallen angels, eternal separation from God and eternal life with God into the appropriate circles. We learned about Elijah and how God protected him.

During language arts the third graders reviewed the story *The Sun*. The fourth graders read *We The People* and *See How They Run*. The students are learning about adverbs, commas, and reviewing verbs. We are finishing up our realistic fiction story. We will begin writing a folk tale next week.

In science we measured matter using bubbles. We measured and recorded three bubbles and found the biggest in our group and the biggest in the class. In social studies we are reviewing the 5 regions of the United States. We are writing 3 facts about each region.
