Objectives: Students will use real world experiences to problem solve and apply strategies of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division while working at the school store (M:PRP:5:1). Students will be able to defend and explain the process used in reaching their conclusion. They will be able to answer questions and give examples to support their decisions. The boys and girls will use a calculator and cash register to provide further evidence and support of their computations. The students will begin to learn about economy and its role in society. (M:PRP:5:2, M:CCR:5:1). Students will see how math fits into their daily lives (M:CCR:5:3). Students will learn to follow multiple step directions (W:OC:3:1.1) and listen and respond to their customers (W:OC:3:1.5b). The students will learn to use courteous manner words and use appropriate language when talking with the customers (W:OC:3:2.1). Students will be able to share Christ with people they encounter and know that God provides for all our needs.
