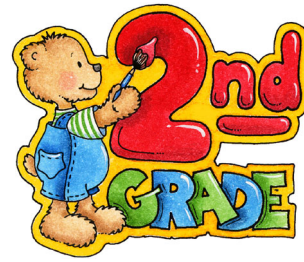


September 21, 2020

Here is what our new week will look like:



Bible: We will be studying Moses, Exodus, and reviewing the first unit Friday.

Monthly Bible Verse: “***Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved.***” Mark 16:16

Writing: The students use their morning journals twice a week. I will introduce more grammar games. We will write a list, common and proper nouns, action verbs, summarizing and organizing information, sequence, helping and linking verbs, and alphabetical order.

Math: We will have our math test on Monday. We will count to add, add facts to 10, order property of addition, count back to subtract, and math facts.

Reading: We read with friends, listen, and comprehend. The read silently and select books that are a good fit for them. We will finish ***The Elves and the Shoemaker*** and start reading ***The Lion and the Mouse***. Each story we read as a class, listen on a CD, and read with a buddy. We learn the new vocabulary words that go along with the story.

Science: We will be studying the plants and seeds.

Social Studies: We will be looking at My Community, My County.

Spelling: We will be working on a spelled a and a_e, i spelled i and i_e, o spelled o and o_e, and u spelled u and u_e words. For homework, they will write sentences using their spelling words. They need to use all of the spelling words (including the bonus words) and they may use up to two spelling words in a sentence. The homework will be due on Wednesday. They will need to be able to write the verse out at the end of every month for a Bible quiz.

Vocabulary: leather, shoemaker, elves, finest, and flash.

Reminders: I would like every child to bring a water bottle to class.
