During **Bible** class we have been looking at different tools to help us understand the Bible. We read about Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch. God sent Philip to help the eunuch understand the passage from Isaiah about Jesus. Today, the Holy Spirit works through the Word and Sacraments to show us our sin and our need for Jesus. We are blessed with pastors, teachers, and family members to help us understand God's word.
