Hello Families,

**Bible:** We will be studying the Snake on the Pole and God's people building a memorial. Matthew 22:37 is our memory verse: ***You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.***

**Writing:** The students use their morning journals twice a week. I will introduce more grammar games. We will go over writing a list, complete and incomplete sentences, common and proper nouns, action verbs, summarizing and organizing information, sequence, helping and linking verbs, subject and predicate, and alphabetical order.

**Math:** We will use fact families to 14, problem solving, pictures, review, test, and math facts.

**Reading:** We will be working on reading with friends, listening, and comprehending. The students will work on silent reading and selecting books that are a good fit for them. We will read ***Ant! They are Hard Workers***. Our newsletter is called ***Let's Explore***. Each story we will read as a class, listen on a CD, and read with a buddy. We will learn the new vocabulary words that go along with the story. We are also learning about fantasy and reality.

**Science:** We will be learning about vertebrate animals.

**Social Studies:** We will be looking at ***My Community, My County***.

**Spelling:** We will be working on the e sound spelled ea, ee, e, and a few fry words. For homework, they will write sentences using their spelling words. They need to use all of the spelling words (including the bonus words) and they may use up to two spelling words in a sentence. The homework will be due on Thursday. They will need to be able to write the verse out at the end of every month for a Bible quiz.
