Harvest Party: We will have a Harvest Party at the end of the day on Friday, Oct. 30th. Some kids have signed up to bring food; it is important that any food brought in be pre-packaged and peanut/tree nut free. No costumes, please.

Parent/Teacher Conferences: There is a 12 noon dismissal on Thursday, 11/5 and no school on Friday, 11/6 for parent teacher conferences. Recess + Snow: If we have snow on the ground, students must come to school with appropriate snow clothes in order to play in the snow during recess. Snow boots should be brought to school separate from sneakers/shoes; they mark the floors and are unwieldy to walk around in. Some parents find it helpful to keep a pair of snow boots at school for this reason.
