The boys and girls have been very busy in the classroom. There have been some great discussions during Bible. I enjoy hearing the children's questions as they try to understand and make connections to what we are learning about.



During Bible we learned about angels and what they do. We read Genesis 3:1-24 about the fall into sin. We know that God promised to send a Savior to save us from our sins. God loves us so much that He sent His Son Jesus to die for us. The students read from 1King 17. We read how God cared for Elijah, the widow, and her son.

In language arts the third graders read *The Go-Around Dollar*. We are reviewing comparative and superlative adjectives and the inflectional ending –ed. We are writing our first descriptive poem.



During science we started a new unit continuing with plants. We learned about different root systems and why they help the plant live in a particular habitat. God made plants in an amazing way.
