**Bible:** We will study The Baptism of Jesus, Jesus Calling His Disciples, Come and See Jesus, and Jesus Goes to A Wedding. March Bible Verses - ***Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.***

**Writing:** The students use their morning journals twice a week. I will introduce more grammar games. We will go over writing a list, compare and contrast, complete and incomplete sentences, common and proper nouns, action verbs, summarizing and organizing information, sequence, helping and linking verbs, subject and predicate, adjectives, open and closed syllables, plurals, synonyms, antonyms, possessive nouns and pronouns, pronouns, conjunctions, compound words and alphabetical order.

**Math:** We will practice: counting money, half-dollar and dollar, exchanging coins to dollars, problem solving, money, and math facts. We take our math test Friday.

**Reading:** We will be working on reading with friends, listening, and comprehending. The students will work on silent reading and selecting books that are a good fit for them. We will read ***How to Hide an Octopus and Other Sea Creatures***. Each story we will read as a class, listen on a CD, and read silently.

We will learn the new vocabulary words that go along with the story. We are also learning about fantasy and reality. **Spelling:** We will be working on OO words.

**Science:** We are learning about habitats. **Social Studies:** We will start looking at The World Around Us. **Vocabulary:** creatures, delay, glides, designed, fade, proceeds. **Reminders:** I would like every child to bring a water bottle to class.
