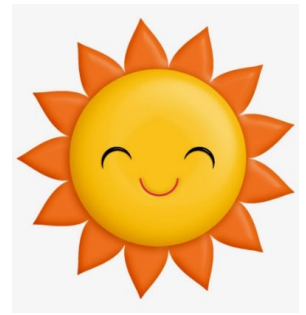


Mrs. Acosta's 3rd – 4th Grade News June 1-8, 2021

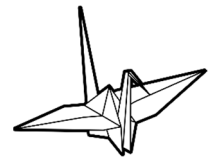
