

Mrs. Acosta's 3rd & 4th Grade News September 7-10, 2021

The boys and girls are learning our classroom routine and schedule. We will start our spelling & geography next week.



In Bible we are reviewing how God made the world. The students learned about what God made on each day. We will be writing out our Bible verse on index cards during center time next week to help us memorize it.

In math the third graders are reviewing standard and expanded form, place and value of a number, writing number words, and comparing numbers.

During language arts the third graders took their first benchmark assessment. We looked at the vocabulary for the story we will start reading on Monday. The story is called, ***Rugby and Rosie***. Our theme is "Friendship." I asked the fourth graders to model how to do a "Book Talk." The students will do one book talk and one letter essay each quarter. I will introduce letter essay writing next week.

In science our first unit is on magnets. The boys and girls found objects around the room that were magnet and those that were not. In social studies we are learning about New Hampshire. Our first chapter is on learning how to read a nonfiction text book.



The students are reviewing and learning the Writing Traits. We worked on the "Ideas" writing trait. I read the book, *What You Know First*." The students started writing a paragraph about something they know about. We will share them next week.
