The boys and girls are adjusting to a full week of school. They are working hard on following directions and the procedures of the classroom.

In Bible we are reviewing the days of creation. The students learned about the fall into sin. We read from the Bible how the devil caused Adam and Eve to doubt what God had said. Adam and Eve were sent out of the Garden of Eden. There were consequences to their sin that we still have today. We know that God promised to send a Savior to save us from our sins. We read about how Cain killed Abel and why God did not regard Cain's offering as highly as Abel's.
