We had a good week. Please make sure that your child does their spelling homework, and it is ready to turn it in Wednesday. **We have share on Tuesday.** The children can bring in one thing each Tuesday to show their classmates or they can have a talking share. **Bible:** We will be finishing our first unit. The test will be Monday. We will start the next unit with The Promised Land. They need to write or say the Bible verse by the month's end for a Bible quiz grade.

**Writing:** The students use their morning journals twice a week. We have worked on common and proper nouns, alphabetical order, action verbs, sequence, helping verbs, linking verbs, and subject and predicate.

**Math:** We will be working on use addition to check, count up to subtract, fact families, missing addends, and math facts.

**Reading:** We will be working on reading with friends, listening, and comprehending. The students will work on silent reading and selecting books that are a good fit for them. We are working in our Kindness unit. We will finish ***The Elves and the Shoemaker***. We will start reading The Lion and the Mouse in the middle of the week. The story, spelling, and grammar that go along with it will take at least a week to read and complete. The vocabulary list comes from the story they are reading.



**Vocabulary:** snoozing, raged, furious, gnaw, and repay

**Science:** We are studying the plants and seeds unit.

**Social Studies:** We are starting to look into ***My Community, My County***.

**Spelling:** We will be working on fry words (words that they should know how to spell in second grade). We have spelling homework this week. **Reminders:** Bring a water bottle to class.
