

Mrs. Acosta's 3rd – 4th Grade News THIRD AND FOURTH GRADE NEWS

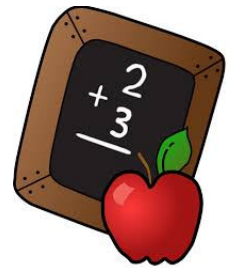
