These warm days of fall seem more like spring. We thank God for the changing of the seasons.

In Bible we have been learning about Abraham. We read about the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. The students read the Bible account of how God destroyed these two cities. Abraham prayed to God to spare Sodom. He prayed with confidence and knew God to be loving and gracious, but also a righteous judge. Ask your child to tell you what happened.

The third graders are reviewing how to add more than two addends and how to find the missing addend. The students learned the math terms commutative property of addition, inverse operation, addend, and sum.

During language arts the third graders read the story ***Teammates***. This is a biography about Jackie Robinson and Pee Wee Reese. The students reviewed antonyms, synonyms, compound words, and contractions.

We located the topic sentence of a paragraph and the supporting details. At the writing center, the third and fourth graders wrote what they are thankful for and we are completing our creation book at the art center.



In science we will be having a unit test on magnets. The test will be on Wednesday. We will have a review on Monday. The students will take home their science packets to study for the test. In social studies we are working on the New Hampshire state symbols and making a book of them.
