

Mrs. Acosta's 3rd-4th Grade News

(October 18 – 22, 2021)

The students enjoyed hearing the presentation about apples from Mr. and Mrs. Hauri. We were able to learn about heirloom apples, pick some to bring home, and have a special snack.

During Bible we learned about Sodom and Gomorrah. God saved Lot and his two daughters. We are learning about Abraham and how he obeyed God. God saved Isaac and provided a ram for the sacrifice. We will have our **Bible unit 1 test** on Thursday. The students will bring home a study guide on Tuesday to review for the test.



In math the third graders are learning about estimating. Last week we learned about front end estimation and this week we are learning about estimating by rounding. The students practiced rounding to the nearest ten or ten cents and to the nearest hundred or dollar.

During language arts the third graders read the story ***One Small Place in a Tree***. The boys and girls reviewed text structure, cause and effect, and author's purpose. The students practiced writing singular words into plural words. These words followed a pattern. They are called regular plurals. During our centers the we wrote a letter to **American House** and finished our creation book.

In science we had our test on magnets. Next week we will begin a new unit on the Earth's Surface. The boys and girls will learn about different types of rocks. In social studies we worked on our New Hampshire symbols book. We added the purple finch and white-tailed deer.
