## Tuition Grants for 2022-2023

Families who were given EFA (Education Freedom Account) grants last year are submitting their forms. These parents will submit the results of our May 9-3 Iowa Achievement Tests for reviewing the Educational Attainment reviews.

For the families who are applying their first time, they should apply for EFA online at <https://nh.scholarshipfund.org/apply/nh-education-freedom-accounts/> . The deadline for all the forms to be submitted is July 15.

Families who have not received awards should also apply with the Trinity Tuition Assistance program, has helped families afford Trinity School.

There are two ways to apply for financial assistance for your child's educational needs:

- Education Freedom Accounts (EFA)
- &
- Education Tax Credit (ETC) scholarships

Please note, if you are eligible it is possible to apply for and receive assistance through *both* programs.

#### Am I eligible?

##### To be eligible:

- 1 You must be a New Hampshire resident. (EFA and ETC)
- 2 Your child must be at least 5 years old and no older than 20 years old and entering K-12th grade. (EFA and ETC)
- 3 Your family's income must be at or below 300% of the federal poverty level guidelines shown in the chart below. (EFA and ETC)

The application is available in many languages. Go to the Select Language dropdown list at the top right of the screen to find your language.



**DEADLINES:** The deadline to apply for a full EFA is **Friday, July 15th, 2022**. There is no deadline for new applications for ETC scholarships, but you are encouraged to apply as soon as possible because the scholarships are first come, first served.
