Hello Families,

I pray you had a wonderful break. Please make sure that your child is still passing in their spelling homework by Wednesday. We still have popcorn on Wednesdays. It is 50 cents a week if you would like your child to have popcorn. You may also have your child bring an extra snack.



We do have share on Wednesdays. The children can bring in one thing each Wednesday to show their classmates or they can have a talking share. The object will need to be able to fit into their backpack. This week, we'll have:

Bible: We will be learning about Elijah and the Widow and God Speaks to Elijah. They will need to be able to write or verbally say the Bible verse by the end of the month for a Bible quiz grade.

May Bible Verses:

1 John 3:18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.

Writing: The students use their morning journals twice a week. We are focusing on adjectives, singular and plural nouns, capitalization, descriptive writing, kinds of sentences, complete and incomplete sentences, plurals, synonyms, antonyms, compound words, contractions, possessive nouns, possessive pronouns, conjunctions, compound sentences, prefixes (dis, un, mis, and mid), suffixes (ly, y, less, and ful), inflectional and comparative endings, irregular plurals, colons, cause and effect, commas in dialogue, homographs, homophones, sequence, quotations, verb tense, authors purpose, and silent consonants.

Math: We will work on place value of three-digit numbers, expanding forms with hundreds, tens, and ones, counting patterns with 3-digit numbers, and compare numbers to 1,000.

Reading: We started our new reading unit. It is America's People. We will be reading April and her Family. The students will work on silent reading and selecting books that are a good fit for them. The story, spelling, and grammar that go along with it will take at least a week to read and complete. The vocabulary list comes from the story that they are reading.



Vocabulary: orchid, discover, sesame, chores, explorer, popular, and wiser

Science: We are working in our energy unit.

Social Studies: We will start to learn about Celebrating Our Traditions.

Spelling: We will be looking at contrast sounds/spelling the long o and ow, the long oo and u, and long oo and oo. The homework will be due on Wednesday.
