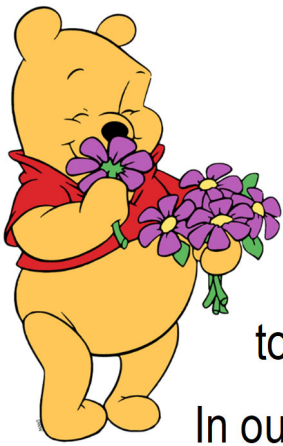


Mrs. Acosta's 3rd-4th Grade News
